People who are honest with history universally agree that Jesus is a historical figure. The evidence of his existence dwarfs many ancient figures, including many world leaders of the time. What's the difference between trusting in Jesus and believing in a historical Jesus? Let's take a look.

To trust in Jesus means that I

1. Acknowledge that I need a Savior.

2. Recognize Jesus as the only God who can save.

3. I believe on Him.

4. Declare that He is my Lord.
